Central Wisconsin Virtual (CWV), created by and in collaboration with the Tomorrow River School District, will be utilizing the services of the Wisconsin Virtual School, which is the designated virtual provider by the Wisconsin Department of Public Instruction, and partnering with CESA 9 to provide viable course options for all learners. CWV online opportunities will enhance learning for all students by providing options that include:

- Relevant courses in flexible locations using an accommodating time schedule
- All courses are taught by certified WI teachers
- High quality, interactive courses aligned to state and national standards
- Kindergarten through high school level curricula
- Over 70 different course options
- Advanced Placement (AP) courses not already offered at Amherst High School
- Modified rates of learning to accommodate the student – traditional, accelerated or extended
- The experience of online learning in preparation for future training in post-secondary education work and environments

CENTRAL WISCONSIN VIRTUAL

The goal will be to implement Central Wisconsin Virtual (CWV) starting with the 2011-2012 school year pending on interest and board approval for students from Kindergarten through 12th grade. Providing students with an online learning option will help the district meet the needs of all students. Online learning may be utilized by all students across the learning spectrum.

COURSE INFORMATION

Central Wisconsin Virtual courses are aligned to national and state standards. Course goals and objectives will be available upon request. Students currently enrolled at Amherst High School full-time can enrich their course selection with courses not currently offered. CWV courses cannot replace courses offered on-site. Students in a full-time home-based learning environment have access to all available coursework.

All courses are 1 to 2 semester courses, and students are given 5 months from the date of enrollment to complete each course for Fall and Spring terms. The number of concurrent courses, being completed at any one time, will be determined by the school district. Each student will develop a virtual education plan. All courses are taught by Wisconsin certified teachers.
