Inappropriate Language: Disruptive language not suited for school use	Profanity: Use of obscene or foul language including swearing and slurs
Invading Personal Space: Not keeping hands, feet and other objects to oneself	Physical Aggression: Intentional use of force against another including inappropriate contact and throwing of objects for the purpose of causing harm
Noncompliance: Not following directions as they are intended with one reminder	Defiance: Intentionally ignoring a staff delivered directive or knowingly breaking a school rule after being directed
Disruption: A disorderly outburst causing interruption within the school environment	Disruption: A disorderly outburst causing interruption within the school environment that cannot be redirected by staff
Property Misuse: Not handling school or personal property in a protective way or as it is intended or allowed to be used. Electronic devices, including cell phones, must be turned off and kept in backpacks while school is in session	Vandalism: Intentional and malicious destruction of the property of others causing financial loss
Unexcused Tardy: Arriving to school and in the classroom after the 8:05 bell without an acceptable excuse	Truancy: Excessively missing school as determined by the truancy law
Lying: Deliberate act of hiding or changing the truth	Lying: Deliberate act of repeatedly hiding or changing the truth with no remorse even after redirection
Unsafe Behavior: Activity that could be harmful to oneself or others	Weapons: Possession of a knife, gun, ammunition, or anything associated with causing harm toward another person
Cheating: Copying answers from someone else or using resources for answers when not approved by a staff member	
Dress Code: Not following guidelines for respectful dress at school and having to cover up and/or change	
Classroom Unpreparedness: Coming to school without necessary materials and assignments to be successful in the learning environment	
Teasing: Verbal behavior intended to disturb or embarrass someone else	Harassment/Bullying: Verbal or cyber-related behavior intended to disturb, upset, embarrass, or harm someone else
	Stealing: Intentional taking of another person's property without that person's permission
