- Be an Amherst high school senior and *pursuing an agricultural-related or natural resources degree*
- Be enrolled in an accredited 2 or 4 year college for the next school year
- 3.0 GPA or above

Applicants for the Evelyn Pionkowski Memorial Scholarship should submit:

1. A completed application form
2. A response to the following essay questions, no more than one page:
  - Who inspired you to pursue a career in agriculture?
  - What are your life goals using your degree in agriculture?
