7. Attached also a maximum of 2 letters of recommendation, of which not more than 1 is from a current or past teacher. If letters of recommendation are coming in a separate, please inform us to this. The deadline for the recommendations letter is also **April 2nd, 2019**.
8. The successful applicant must be a permanent resident of the central Wisconsin area.
9. Preference will be given to family members of the GSHBA membership.
